*The objective of the conference is to discuss
physical phenomena and processes in organic and
inorganic materials and at their interfaces to other
materials, as well as prospects of their practical
applications.*

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM:

1. Electronic processes at interfaces of organic materials with metals, as well as biological, organic, and inorganic media;
2. Electro-optic processes in liquid-crystal-based heterogeneous systems;
3. Thin film structures and their application;
4. Electronic processes in nanostructures and polymer composites;
5. Nonlinear properties of polymer composites, nanostructures, NLO information recording;
6. Novel materials, structures, and technologies;
7. Bio- systems and problems of energy conservation;
8. Physics and technology of organic solar cells, LEDs, FETs, sensors. Conjugated thin films for electrochromic devices.

Lectures (30-45 minutes), oral reports (15-20 minutes), and posters will be presented at the conference.

PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE:

Applicants have to send the application form and abstracts of their reports written according to the rules indicated below to the Organizing Committee. **Please, submit the application form and abstract by e-mail to the secretary: valeryovdenko@gmail.com or registration on-line in site till December 30, 2017 (deadline).** The Program Committee will inform authors about the acceptance of their contributions **before February 15, 2018.**

The official language of the Conference is English.

The registration fee is 150 USD which includes conference materials, conference program, book of abstracts, coffee break refreshments, a banquet, a tour through the historic center of the Ivano-Frankivsk town, rent a conference room and presentation equipment, transfer (for overseas participants) from the railway station to the conference venue and back. The fee for Ukrainian participants from the state budget organizations may be reduced to 600 UAH thanks to the special grant. The fee for students may be decreased by two times if they point to the need for discounts in the application form. There will be no discount for application forms sent after December 30, 2017.

APPLICATION SHOULD CONTAIN:

- ♦ full title of report ;
- ♦ names and affiliations of authors,
- ♦ name of a lecturer, his/her title, phone, e-mail postal address;
- ♦ number of the conference section;
- ♦ type of the contribution (lecture, oral or poster report) and duration (for lecture and oral report).
- ♦ ask for the support (for students)

RULES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS:

1. Abstracts in English should be prepared as a single A5 page (including figures, tables, references, etc.)
2. Abstracts should be typed in Microsoft Word (Office 97/2000 format) using single-spaced Times New Roman 9,5 pt font according to template.
3. The title is typed at the top of the page, using capital letters without hyphenation. Leave one blank lines before author's names, their addresses and affiliations. Leave one blank lines and then type the text of the Abstract.
4. Formulae and figures should be inserted in the text and, if necessary, be attached in separate files with a specification of the used graphic program.
5. References should be given in the report body (for example, [1]), and their list should be typed leaving two blank lines after the body of the abstract.

PROCEEDINGS SUBMISSION:

1. It is planned to publish ICEPOM-11 Proceedings in the special issue of the international journal. The specifications will be given later on conference web site of the ICEPOM-11: <http://icepom.in.ua>
2. Report text prepared according to the rules of the journal should be submitted to the representative of the Organizing Committee at the registration.
